

Report on MUR performance in Essex LPC for 2007/8

33197 MURs were claimed for by 233 (out of 298) contractors during the year. This represented an increase of 70% in numbers claimed and is 28% of the maximum that could have been claimed in the 12 months.

Essex claimed the second highest total after NE London (35704)

27 contractors claimed for the full 400 (16 CCA, 5 AIM and 6 Independent)
150 (50%) claimed for less than 1 a week and 68 did not claim for any.

23 contractors who claimed last year did not claim this year.

The top 10% of contractors accounted for 33% of the claims.

42% of the claimants belong to the CCA and accounted for 60% of MURs claimed
10% of the claimants belong to AIM and accounted for 11% of MURs claimed
48% of the claimants are independent and accounted for 30% of MURs claimed

Mid Essex and North East Essex produced the best performance claiming for 33% of their maximum possible number.

Locality analysis is as follows

Mid Essex

33% of the maximum number of MURS were claimed
12%(7) of contractors claimed 40 % (2775) of MURs claimed
45% (24) claimed for less than 1/week including 19 % (10) who did not claim for any

North East

33% of the maximum number of MURS were claimed
18%(9) of contractors claimed 57 % (3555) of MURs claimed
45% (22) claimed for less than 1/week including 21 % (10) who did not claim for any

South East

23% of the maximum number of MURS were claimed
6%(4) of contractors claimed 24 % (1600) of MURs claimed
53% (38) claimed for less than 1/week including 27 % (20) who did not claim for any

South West

31% of the maximum number of MURS were claimed
8%(6) of contractors claimed 25 % (2400) of MURs claimed
49% (39) claimed for less than 1/week including 16 % (13) who did not claim for any

West

19% of the maximum number of MURS were claimed
2%(1) of contractors claimed 11 % (400) of MURs claimed
65% (30) claimed for less than 1/week including 33 % (15) who did not claim for any
